

Hello Everyone!

Registration for the 2026-2027 season will be opening within a week. Here is some information to help you prepare for registration.

Account Information:

- To prepare for registration, log in or create your Uplifter account. Uplifter is the Club's online registration and fees payment platform. Check all the details under "Account Details and Addresses". Make sure that the account is in the name of the parent/guardian not the skater. The skater should be listed under "Participant". Confirm that the name, address, phone number and email address is correct. If you need to edit anything use the "Edit Details" button on the top right. You can also add a secondary email address, if you like. This is also a good time to make sure that your password is active.
- When you review your account, please also review your communication preferences. We recommend that you select YES to all the choices so that you won't miss any of the emails that we send you, such as volunteer opportunities, newsletters, and information about upcoming events.

CanSkate:

- CanSkate program prices are based on one session per week. Registering for additional days qualifies you for a discount. (2 days per week = 10% off, 3 days per week = 15% off). PFSC also offers a 10% sibling discount: full price applies to the first skater, with the discount applied to each additional skater in the same family. All skaters must be registered in CanSkate to qualify.
- All CanSkate participants must have their own skates, and a CSA approved hockey helmet. Bike and other non-approved helmets are not acceptable as they do not meet the Skate Canada insurance policy standards. There are no rentals available during our sessions.

STARSkate (Junior, Intermediate, Senior and Adult)

- To register for Junior programs, skaters must have completed CanSkate or received advancement from a professional coach. For more information, please contact info@peninsulafigureskatingclub.com.
- Coaching fees are not included in listed prices unless specified. Those requiring coaching should contact their coach or email info@peninsulafigureskatingclub.com to make arrangements. Coaches typically invoice families directly on a monthly basis.
- STARSkate participants are not required to enter competitions; however skaters who wish to compete are advised to register according to the recommendations below.
- For skaters who wish to compete please contact your coach for direction and more information. Please be aware that there will be additional fees for competition entry, travel and coaching.
- Recommended amount of skating time for skaters wishing to compete;
 - STAR 1: 1 – 2 days per week
 - STAR 2 - 3: 2 – 3 days per week
 - STAR 4 +: 3+ days per week

- Open sessions are available to all STARSkaters.

- STARSkate Discounts:
 - 3 days per week – 10%
 - 4 - 5 days per week – 15% off

Equipment/Attire:

- Proper skates are very important for comfort and safety. Please visit our website at www.peninsulafigureskatingclub.com and watch the short video at the bottom of the page for information on selecting proper equipment for CanSkate.
- STARSkate/CanSkate (figure skates):
 - Pete's Skate Shop (Langford), Cyclone Taylor Figure Skating (Vancouver), Skater's Edge Boutique (Coquitlam).
- CanSkate:
 - Activewear which allows for movement, hair out of eyes, no denim pants, dress warm (including gloves or mittens) and comfortable.
- STARSkate:
 - Long hair pulled back out of face, activewear, no loose-fitting pants or sweaters.
- Off Ice:
 - If attending an off ice fitness class, please make sure you read the list of what to bring that is printed on your invoice.

Other:

- All sessions run from September to April. We skate on all holidays unless you are notified otherwise.

- PFSC is a non-profit organization that relies upon skating fees and extensive fundraising to pay for ice rental and professional skating coaches. We strive to keep our fees as low as we can to ensure accessibility to all families in our community.
